REPRESENTING JESUS AND HIS KINGDOM

1) We Get a New Perspective

So from now on we regard no one from a worldly point of view. Though we once regarded Christ in this way, we do so no longer. Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!

[2 Corinthians 5:16-17]

“For this world in its present form is passing away.” [1 Corinthians 7:31]

2) Sent on a Mission of Reconciliation

“All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting people’s sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation.” [2 Corinthians 5:18-19]

3) Representing Jesus and His Kingdom

“We are therefore Christ’s ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ’s behalf: Be reconciled to God.”

[2 Corinthians 5:20]

“But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.” [Matthew 6:33]

“Pray also for me, that whenever I speak, words may be given me so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the gospel, for which I am an ambassador in chains. Pray that I may declare it fearlessly, as I should.” [Ephesians 6:19-20]

4) Because of the Cross

“God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.” [2 Corinthians 5:21]

“All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.” [Isaiah 53:6, KJV]
