Victory to defeat...be careful out there

Compromise and defeat

Jericho and everything in it...as an **offering to the Lord**..."Do not take any of the things...or you yourselves will be completely destroyed, and you will bring trouble..."...But Israel **violated** the instructions about the things set apart for the Lord. A man named Achan had stolen some of these dedicated things, so the Lord was very angry with the Israelites...So approximately 3,000 warriors were sent, but they were soundly **defeated**... Joshua 6:17-18; 7:1,4

Consequences

...The Israelites were **paralyzed with fear**...and their **courage melted away**... Joshua 7:5

Pathway to destruction

"Among the plunder I **saw**...200 silver coins, and a bar of gold weighing more than a pound. I **wanted** them so much that I **took** them. They are **hidden**..." They piled a great heap of stones over Achan, which remains to this day.... Joshua 7:21,26
