## I AM THE VINE

*"I am the true vine, and my Father is the gardener. Every branch in me that does not produce fruit he removes, and he prunes every branch that produces fruit so that it will produce more fruit. You are already clean because of the word I have spoken to you. Remain in me, and I in you. Just as a branch is unable to produce fruit by itself unless it remains on the vine, neither can you unless you remain in me. I am the vine; you are the branches. The one who remains in me and I in him produces much fruit, because you can do nothing without me. If anyone does not remain in me, he is thrown aside like a branch and he withers. They gather them, throw them into the fire, and they are burned. If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you want and it will be done for you. My Father is glorified by this: that you produce much fruit and prove to be my disciples. As the Father has loved me, I have also loved you. Remain in my love. If you keep my commands you will remain in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commands and remain in his love. I have told you these things so that my joy may be in you and your joy may be complete." [John 15:1-11]*

### 1) The Christian life is fruit-bearing.

We are saved by faith alone, but the faith that saves is never alone.

*"...you can do nothing without me." [John 15:5]*

*The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. [Galatians 5:22-23]*

### 2) The Christian life is abiding.

*"Just as a branch is unable to produce fruit by itself unless it remains on the vine, neither can you unless you remain in me." [John 15:4]*

*"If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you want and it will be done for you." [John 15:7]*

### 3) The Christian life is perfecting.

*"...he prunes every branch that produces fruit so that it will produce more fruit." [John 15:2]*

We tend to think of Christianity as a painless system by which we can escape the penalty of past sins and attain to heaven at last. [But] it is necessary for God to use the hammer, the file, and the furnace in His holy work of preparing a saint for true sainthood. *It is doubtful whether God can bless a man greatly until He has hurt him deeply.* [A.W. Tozer]

### 4) The Christian life is joy-giving.

*"I have told you these things so that my joy may be in you and your joy may be complete." [John 15:11]*
