A STORY ABOUT DAD

All the tax collectors and sinners were approaching to listen to him. And the Pharisees and scribes were complaining, "This man welcomes sinners and eats with them."

[Luke 15:1-2]

He also said: "A man had two sons. The younger of them said to his father, 'Father, give me the share of the estate I have coming to me.' So he distributed the assets to them. I'm no longer worthy to be called your son. **Make me like one of your hired workers.**"' So he got up and went to his father. But while the son was still a long way off, his father saw him and was filled with compassion. He ran, threw his arms around his neck, and kissed him. The son said to him, 'Father, I have sinned against heaven and in your sight. I'm no longer worthy to be called your son.'

"But the father told his servants, 'Quick! Bring out the best robe and put it on him; **put a ring on his finger** and sandals on his feet. "Then he became angry and didn't want to go in. **So his father came out and pleaded with him.** But he replied to his father, 'Look, I have been slaving many years for you, and **I have never disobeyed your orders**, yet you never gave me a goat so that I could celebrate with my friends. But when this son of yours came, who has devoured your assets with prostitutes, you slaughtered the fattened calf for him.'
