LISTEN UP: John 14:15-17

#### A culture of instant access

"I am the Good Shepherd. I know my own, and my own know me...and <u>they</u> <u>will listen to my voice</u>." (John 10:14,16b)

Not audible...but accessible

A voice of direction, guidance, and comfort

Tension: if God DOES speak...why haven't I experienced it?

Silence must mean...

#### 1. I can be confident that God WANTS to speak to me

If you love me, you will keep my commands. And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Counselor to be with you forever. He is the Spirit of truth. The world is unable to receive him because it doesn't see him or know him. But you do know him, because he remains with you and will be in you. (John 14:15-17).

Don't you yourselves know that you are God's temple and that the Spirit of God lives in you? (1 Corinthians 3:16).

(For further study see: Romans 8:9,11; 1 Corinthians 6:19; 2 Corinthians 6:16; Galatians 4:6; 2 Timothy 1:14; James 4:5; 1 John 3:24, 4:4)

#### 2. I can hear God's voice when I find QUIET

Quiet is an essential ingredient for both listening AND spiritual growth

Then he said, "Go out and stand on the mountain in the Lord's presence." At that moment, the Lord passed by. A great and mighty wind was tearing at the mountains and was shattering cliffs before the Lord, but the Lord was not in the wind. After the wind there was an earthquake, but the Lord was not in the earthquake. After the earthquake there was a fire, but

the Lord was not in the fire. And after the fire there was a voice, a soft whisper. (1 Kings 19:11-12).

Most translations read: "a soft whisper" or "hardly a sound."

there was a sound. Thin. Quiet. (CEB) there was a quiet, gentle sound. (NCV) a still, small voice. (KJV)

God's indwelling Spirit doesn't contradict Scripture "The Spirit is leading me..." vs. "The Scripture says..."

Practical: "Yesterday, I..." Was there something that happened where I missed out on what You were trying to communicate to me?

#### 3. I can hear God's voice when I MEDITATE on God's word

Focus & Worry

Easy to read past truth

God's Word is His love letter to you

How can a young man keep his way pure? By keeping your word... I have treasured your word in my heart so that I may not sin against you... I will meditate on your precepts and think about your ways. (Psalm 119:9,11,15).

Practical: Write it out

And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead lives in you, then he who raised Christ from the dead will also bring your mortal bodies to life through his Spirit who lives in you. (Romans 8:11).
