Teaching ESL gives them the opportunity to serve together and teach a free, two-hour class for a small group of adults.

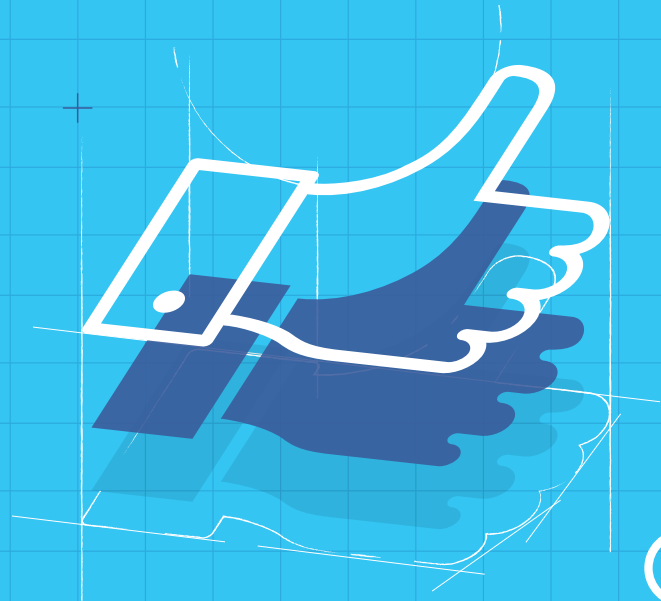
“Being part of a team is like having another family,” said Karen. “It is exciting to see others become more confident in speaking English, give them a practical skill and share Christ's love with them.”
