### 1) Being filled with the Spirit is God's will for you.

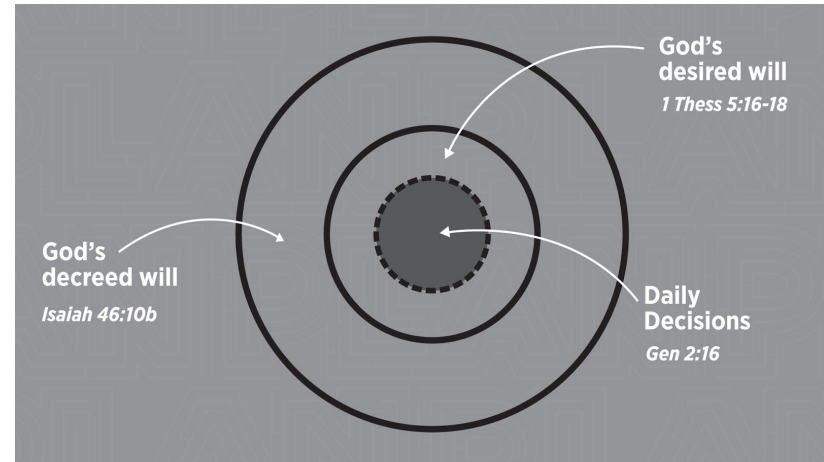
#### Two ways to live:
