



# HE WILL BRING JOY TO ALL NATIONS

After these things God tested Abraham and said to him, "Abraham!" "Here I am," he answered. "Take your son," he said, "your only son Isaac, whom vou love, go to the land of Moriah, and offer him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains I will tell you about."
