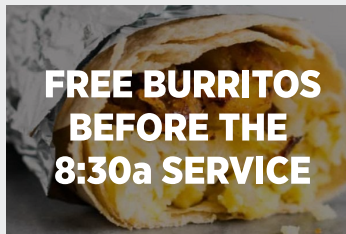

HOW TO FIGHT...

Conflict is inevitable... but misery is optional.

If possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone.
(Romans 12:18)

Biblical conflict

“You have heard that it was said to our ancestors, Do not murder, and whoever murders will be subject to judgment. But I tell you, everyone who is angry with his brother or sister will be subject to judgment.” (Matthew 5:21-22a)

A PLAN FOR FIGHTING WELL & A PATH TO PEACE

1. NAME IT: *I do this so I can move forward, grow, change, (if necessary) and love.*

2. DELAY IT: *I do this so I don't hurt others and damage relationships.*

A fool gives full vent to his anger, but a wise person holds it in check.
(Proverbs 29:11)

Even fools are thought to be wise when they keep silent; with their mouths shut, they seem intelligent. (Proverbs 17:28)

Depend on God's Spirit to guide you

So I say, let the Holy Spirit guide your lives. Then you won't be doing what your sinful nature craves. The sinful nature wants to do evil, which is just the opposite of what the Spirit wants. And the Spirit gives us desires that are the opposite of what the sinful nature desires. (Galatians 5:16-17a)

But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. (Galatians 5:22-23)

Those who belong to Christ Jesus have nailed the passions and desires of their sinful nature to his cross and crucified them there. Since we are living by the Spirit, let us follow the Spirit's leading in every part of our lives. Let us not become conceited, or provoke one another, or be jealous of one another. (Galatians 5:24-26)

3. STUDY IT: *I do this so I can learn, improve my relationships, and grow closer to Jesus.*

Why am I angry?

- Fear
- Hurt

Know that the LORD has set apart the faithful for himself; the LORD will hear when I call to him. Be angry and do not sin; on your bed, reflect in your heart and be still. (Psalm 4:3-4)
