HOW TO COMPLAIN TO GOD

A Maskil of David. When he was in a cave. A prayer. Prescript to Psalm 142

I cry aloud to the LORD; I plead aloud to the LORD for mercy. I pour out my complaint before him; I reveal my trouble to him. Psalm 142:1-2

Although my spirit is weak within me, you know my way. Along this path I travel they have hidden a trap for me. Look to the right and see: no one stands up for me; there is no refuge for me; no one cares about me. I cry to you, LORD; I say, "You are my shelter, my portion in the land of the living." Listen to my cry, for I am very weak. Rescue me from those who pursue me, for they are too strong for me. Free me from prison so that I can praise your name.
