Stay out of danger Proverbs 11:1-6 Dishonest scales are detestable to the LORD, but an accurate weight is his delight. Proverbs 11:1

God loves honesty...hates dishonestly

When arrogance comes, disgrace follows, but with humility comes wisdom. Proverbs 11:2

Humility brings wisdom

The integrity of the upright guides them, but the perversity of the treacherous destroys them. Proverbs 11:3 Integrity is our guide
