OVERVIEW:

LEAN IN: BREAK THE ICE

Read 1 Corinthians 12:1-13:3

What do you learn about spiritual gifts?



LOOK OUT: IDENTIFY THE RELEVANCE OF GOD'S WORD IN THE WORLD

Where do you see people use their gifts to serve others?

What does it look like when people use their gifts to just serve themselves?



LOOK IN: APPLY GOD'S WORD TO YOUR LIFE

Take time to call out the gifts you've seen at work in each other.

What, if anything, surprises you about the gifts others have seen in you?

Where is God calling you to step further into using your gifts to serve others?
