DEPARTING / DECONSTRUCTION	Leaving Christ or "the faith delivered once and for all" (Jude 3)	Judas

DISENTANGLING	Separating unbiblical beliefs from your faith	Peter
DISENCULTURING	Separating cultural expressions from your faith
