## Nehemiah 3

The men of Jericho built next to Eliashib, and next to them...(V. 2)

Next to them Meremoth...made repairs. (V. 4)

Beside them the Tekoites made repairs... (V. 5)

Next to them...were...Melatiah the Gibeonite... (V. 7)

After him Uzziel son of Harhaiah... (V.8)

Next to them Rephaiah son of Hur... (V. 9)

After him Nehemiah son of Azbuk... (V. 16)

Next to him the Levites made repairs... (V. 17)

Beside him Hashabiah... (V. 17)

After him their fellow Levites...(V. 18)

Next to him Ezer... (V. 19)

After him Baruch... (V. 20)

And next to him the priests...made repairs. (V. 22)

After them Benjamin and Hasshub made repairs... (V. 23)

After him Binnui... (V. 24)

Beside him Pedaiah... (V. 25)

Next to him the Tekoites... (V. 27)

After them Zadok...made repairs... (V. 29)

Next to him Hananiah... (V. 30)

Malchijah son of Rechab, ruler of the district of Beth-haccherem, repaired the Dung Gate. He rebuilt it and installed its doors, bolts, and bars. (Nehemiah 3:14)

After them Jedaiah...made repairs across from his house. (V. 10)

After them Benjamin and Hasshub made repairs opposite their house. (V. 23)

...Maaseiah...made repairs beside his house. (V. 23)

Each of the priests made repairs...opposite his own house. (V. 28)

- ...Zadok...made repairs opposite his house. (V. 29)
- ...Meshullam...made repairs opposite his room. (V. 30)
- ...Baruch...diligently repaired another section... (Nehemiah 3:20)
- ...their nobles did not lift a finger to help their supervisors. (Nehemiah 3:5)
